

Dear Singer & Parents:

Congratulations! You have been selected as a member of the 2019 WCPSS Middle School All County Choral Clinic. The event will take place at FJ Carnage Magnet Middle School on Friday, February 15th from 1:00p - 8:30p, and Sat. February 16th from 9:00a - 4:00p. **The final performance will take place at FJ Carnage Magnet Middle School in Raleigh on Saturday, February 16th at 3:00p.** Parents and guests are encouraged to attend the performance to support your child and their school. There is no admission costs involved with the concert.

You are responsible for learning five pieces. With your teacher's help and the aid of rehearsal tracks, you will learn all of the pitches and rhythms for each piece by Feb. 15th. We will have a special clinician leading our choral rehearsals and conducting our final concert. This person will help us be more expressive and musical in our performance of the pieces, so it is very important that you know your notes and rhythms before February 15th.

The fee to participate in All County is \$20.00 per singer. This pays for your music, as well as for your lunch on Saturday. If you would like an All-County T-Shirt, they will be \$10 per singer. You will pay your school or your school's Choral Boosters, and they will write one check for your schools entire student registration fee and t-shirt order. Please turn your money in to your Choral Director as soon as possible.

Because you have been selected as a representative of your school for this event, Wake County expects only the best from you at rehearsals and the concert. Expectations include:

- Your total and undivided attention to the clinician and all other teachers at all times.
- No cell phones or other digital devices in sight. They will be taken if they are seen or heard.
- No gum
- Show kindness and respect to all adults and students at the event.
