Cost

Student audition registration is \$15 per student. Please include cash or check when returning this form to secure your student's spot due Friday, September 13th.

Directions and Parking

Parents are responsible for driving their students to the audition on September 26th, or arranging a carpool with other parents. The address for Holy Trinity Episcopal Church is [607 N. Greene St., Greensboro 27401](#). When you arrive at the audition site, please drop your students on Greene St. and look for signs that direct you to "MS Honors Chorus Auditions". Cars can park across the street from the church in a parking lot. This lot is used by Hanes Lineberry Funeral Services, but it is first-come, first-served. With that said, do not park in the spots for the veterinary hospital in that lot. They will tow you.

Arrival on Audition Day

Make travel arrangements to arrive and be ready 1 hour before your student's audition time. Exact audition times are yet to be determined, but they should be in the later afternoon between 1-5pm. Martin admin has approved excused absences for students leaving early for the audition. When you arrive, students should meet me inside to check in. I will give them their score sheet and original copy of music. Students will wait in the holding area until the student assistants come to call the individuals to audition. It is extremely important that the holding area stay quiet. Do not rehearse in the holding area. If your student is not ready when his/her name is called, he/she will be skipped. Each student should bring their audition sheet and hand it to the judge, who will keep it when the student is finished.

Teachers and parents are not allowed in the audition rooms or hallways

No one may wait outside of a room to find out how the audition went. Assigned helpers/assistants will be escorting students to the audition rooms. When students have finished with their audition they need to sign back out with me before leaving.
